The firm started with two sewing machines and five workers and made long-lasting clothing for manual workers. The company's first slogan was "Honest value for an honest dollar. To grow the company and add more employees, Carhartt needed to enlarge their global headquarters based in Dearborn, Michigan. "The campus was expanded to provide adequate space for innovation research and product development," Linda Hubbard, Carhartt's president and chief operating officer, said of its expansion in an e-mail, calling it "essential to producing durable, premium apparel for the country's hardest workers."
