The 37,000 sqft, state-of-the-art building houses Macomb Fire Station #1, and Sheriff's Substation #7. The building is equipped with high-efficiency lighting, HVAC units, and plumbing fixtures that will reduce future operational costs. It is one of the newest, most modern, and best-equipped public safety building in the entire county. The facility is designed to accommodate 25 firefighters, and up to 60 law enforcement officers, and will grow with, and serve the community for the next 50 years.

The building features include five drive-through fire apparatus bays, a 14-car garage for Sheriff's vehicles, training and fitness areas, administrative offices for both the fire and sheriff's departments, living and sleeping quarters for on-duty fire fighters. The facility will also serve as the township's Emergency Operation Center during a large-scale emergency.
